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According to the law of Azerbaijan Republic on “turnover of narcotic drugs, psychotropic substances and their precursors” dated 28.06.2005, number 959-IIQ, the turnover of narcotic drugs and psychotropic substances in the territory of Azerbaijan Republic is only allowed for application in medical practice, scientific-research works and prevention of criminal actions.

According to the article 11 of this law, it is allowed to use narcotic drugs and psychotropic substances only for treatment of transit passengers.

According to the decision of the Cabinet of Ministers of Azerbaijan Republic dated 01.07.2006, number 163 on approval of the regulations for passenger crossing the territory of Azerbaijan Republic in transit to carry narcotic drugs and psychotropic substances for treatment purposes and the limit of amount of use of them, the patient crossing the territory of Azerbaijan Republic in transit may carry for treatment purposes other narcotic drugs and psychotropic substances turnover of which was not prohibited in the territory of Azerbaijan republic by the legislation of Azerbaijan Republic.

The patient crossing the territory of Azerbaijan Republic in transit has to declare the narcotic drug or psychotropic substance he possessed for treatment purposes when entering the territory of Azerbaijan Republic in written form, and to submit to the customs authorities the medical document issued by the related competent body of his/her country on availability of the disease requiring application of narcotic drugs and psychotropic substance (their names, quantity, medicine form, application method and date of expiry) and the document confirming (copy of the prescription) that the narcotic drug and psychotropic substances were obtained in legal ways along with the narcotic drugs and psychotropic substances he/she possessed.

The customs authorities check conformity of the name, quantity, medicine form submitted with the presented documents and relevant remarks are made on arrival in the declaration.

Failure by the patient crossing in transit to declare the narcotic drugs and psychotropic substances taken for treatment purposes or if any attempt to bring it in other illegal ways is detected, the same person is applied liability measure defined by the legislation of Azerbaijan Republic.

The patient crossing in transit is obliged to submit the relevant documents and remainders of drug preparations to the customs authorities for inspection in the customs border while leaving the territory of Azerbaijan Republic. The customs authorities check conformity of the remainders of drugpreparations with those stated in the documents and document their taking from the country.

The limit of use amount of the narcotic drugs and psychotropic substances by the patient crossing the territory of Azerbaijan Republic in transit for treatment purposes was stated in the above mentioned decision.

At the same time, we state that according to the article 6.2 of the law of Azerbaijan Republic on medicines dated December 22, 2006, number 208-IIIQ, the state registration of narcotic drugs, psychotropic substances used as drug in the medicine and the turnover of which was prohibited, restricted and controlled in the territory of Azerbaijan Republic, as well as the narcotic drugs, psychotropic substances and their precursors included in the lists approved by the law of Azerbaijan Republic dated June 28, 2005, number 960-IIQ on approval of the lists of precursors for the import, export, transit transportation of which into the territory of Azerbaijan Republic license is required, is conducted taking into account the requirements of the law of Azerbaijan Republic on turnover of narcotic drugs, psychotropic substances and their precursors and other relevant legislative acts.

In addition, we would like to note that according to the article 2.1.7 of the discounted and simplified regulations "for crossing the customs border of the goods not intended for production or commercial purposes by the natural entities"

approved by the decision of the Cabinet of Ministers of Azerbaijan Republic dated October 14, 2013, number 305, the natural entities may bring medicines in the quantity necessary for personal use including the drugs not passed state registration in Azerbaijan Republic to the customs territory.
