1. The Central Election Committee (hereinafter the "Committee"), has prepared the following clarifications regarding the above mentioned RFI.
2. Following is the list and the details of the questions and the clarifications:

No.	Section number and name	Details of the question / request for clarification	Answer / Clarification
1	General	<p>The RFI is referred to a Learning Management System (LMS) whereas the text itself refers also to e-learning software. Is the intention to eventually publish a tender also for developing e-learning software?</p> <p>If so - it is not clear what information is required to provide about the e-learning software that will be developed.</p> <p>This subject is enclosed in a number of clauses in the specifications that are required to be elaborated.</p>	<p>The RFI refers both to a Learning (training) Management System (LMS) and to an e-learning suite. Regarding tender processes, please refer to the relevant provisions in the administration chapter.</p> <p>The intention is to describe the e-learning tool proposed by the information provider, to the extent that he is proposing such e-learning suite, and it's compliance with the Committee's requirements. The intention is not necessarily for an e-learning suite ready for the Knesset elections - though of course it is an option - but also to a situation whereas the information provider has developed e-learning in different fields of content, while it is possible to apply the tool to the theme of Knesset elections.</p>
2	Chapter 2 - Application, Section 2.1.1.1	<p>The question is not clear. Is it required to list the key capabilities of the LMS?</p>	<p>Yes, especially the products (outputs) produced from it.</p>
3	Chapter 2 - Application, Section 2.1.1.2	<p>The question is not clear.</p> <p>A. E-learning suite is not a system.</p> <p>B. There are no products to an e-learning suite.</p>	<p>As far as the RFI is concerned, we refer to e-learning suite as a "system" which has products (outputs), but can also be seen as a sub - system or as a module in an overall system.</p>

No.	Section number and name	Details of the question / request for clarification	Answer / Clarification
			You are invited to describe the proposed e-learning suite, whether it is an already prepared e-learning for elections or whether it is a development tool that can be adapted to elections in accordance with the RFI and the above said.
4	Chapter 2 - Application, Section 2.2.1	It is not clear on which interfaces it is required to specify - as the e-learning suite has not yet been developed yet.	The intention is to describe existing interfaces, in previous applications that you have implemented before, between LMS and e-learning suites. The intention is to learn from the relevant interfaces, and to assess the ability to apply them for the needs of the Committee.
5	Chapter 2 - Application, Section 2.1.2	We request a clarification on this question, Your intention regarding the interface / format to the list of technologies that were specified in this section.	The intention is to the formats in which the output of the proposed system are produced - such as – Are the outputs produced as printer files, or as structured files such as Excel or other output formats.
6	Chapter 2 - Application, Appendix A, Section 2.22.4	What kind of information is referred to in this section? What data will be required to be transferred from the LMS to the website?	At this point, there are no specific requirements to pass information from the LMS to the website. This is a generic question - is there a response / usage in the proposed system, and whether there was such usage in systems did you have implemented in the past.
7	Chapter 2 - Application, Appendix A, Section 2.7	In the RFI you have specified that the project contains three main contents: e-learning suite, a Learning Management System (LMS) and a support center. Can we refer to only part of the contents according the specialization of our company?	Yes.
8	Appendix A, Section 2.7.1, page 26	You require that "the e-learning suite shall be composed of four chapters in the content's areas listed. Every chapter shall have 25 pages of content, interactions, questions, summary and test". Does that mean the development of four separate learning-units? (So it is highly recommended due to the amount of content in each chapter / e-learning suite).	This section reflects the current concept of the Committee. You are invited to refer and to comment on this concept according to your understanding and experience, as part of your response, including your recommendations. The term "Chapter" is equivalent to a "study" unit in this regard.
9	Appendix A, Section 2.7.1, page 26	Is it required to make any "progress blockages" in all of the study units? (They block progress if you have not completed a task or an operation necessary in the session)	You are invited to address this possibility as part of your response.
10	Appendix A, Section 2.7.1, page 26	Is required to make "bookmarks" in all of the study units? (It makes you return to the last point where you were in case you left in the middle of learning)/	You are invited to address this possibility as part of your response.
